

her resume, navigating decision-making in
social environments, and practicing mock
interviews with our employment team.

Currently, she is working as a mail room clerk, where she handles tasks such as sorting mail, managing claims, and greeting mail carriers. In this role, she is continually improving her skills, staying organized, and taking on new responsibilities. Stacie is recognized as one of the strongest team members, reaching one of the highest processing rates in her department!




Sony's Mended Wings

Tempus Unlimited has collaborated with Easterseals to distribute iPads aimed at enhancing independence for individuals within our Adult Foster Care and Supported Living Programs. Easterseals, like Tempus Unlimited, is dedicated to providing programs and services to people with disabilities. Their mission is to ensure that children and adults living with disabilities have equal opportunities to live, learn, work and play.



About the Adult Foster Care Program...

- The Tempus Unlimited Adult Foster Care Program is a MassHealth funded program for individuals who are 16 years of age or older who require at least 21 hours of daily supervision.
- Eligibility requires that the member has a medical or cognitive condition requiring hands on assistance or active supervision in their activities of daily living and a caregiver who lives with them.
- Support is provided through case management and nursing regular in home visits, with support for both the member and caregiver.
