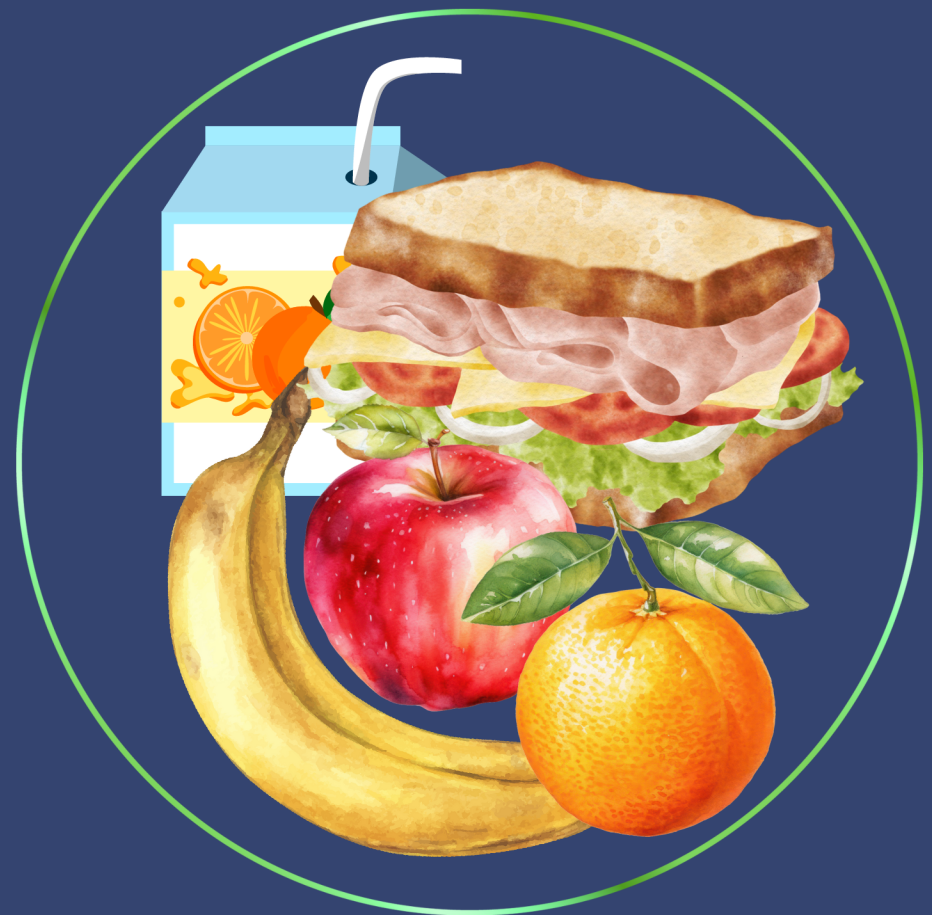

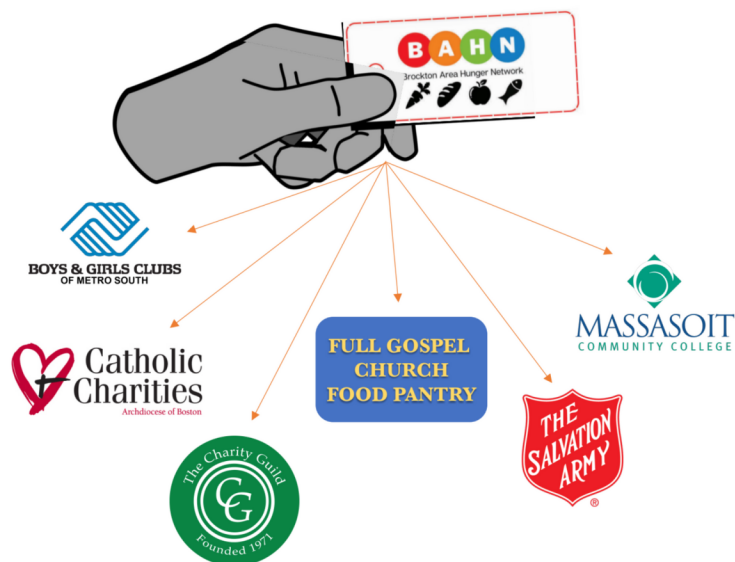

WHY IT IS IMPORTANT TO HAVE ONLY ONE BAHN CARD PER FAMILY

You should only have ONE BAHN CARD per family.

Our pantries are working together to better serve you and your family. In an effort to provide you - with the food that you need - for you and your family, **you MUST use the SAME card and phone number at every pantry location each time you visit a pantry for food.**

Using the SAME CARD will help us ALL continue to provide you with access to the food that you need.



- Your BAHN card does **NOT** impact your access to receiving SNAP benefits.
- Using the SAME BAHN CARD during every pantry visit will give us the opportunity to better provide you with the food that you need.
