Supported Living Program

The Tempus Unlimited Supported Living Program helps adults with physical and developmental disabilities live independently in their own homes and apartments throughout Southeastern Massachusetts. We are committed to the philosophy of consumer empowerment and control. SLP supports each consumer's right to make his or her own decisions and support individuals in taking greater control over

their own lives.

Services provided include:

- Transitional assistance to community living
- Application assistance for affordable and accessible housing
- Advocacy
- Coordination of services and other affairs
- Assistance with securing necessary technology
- Coordination for transportation services
- Social Activities
- Surrogacy and assistance with hiring and management of PCA's
- Assistance with finances, household budgeting
- Arrangements for medical appointments, therapies, and other personal health
- Peer mentoring
- Access to community resources for healthcare, recreational and vocational services
