



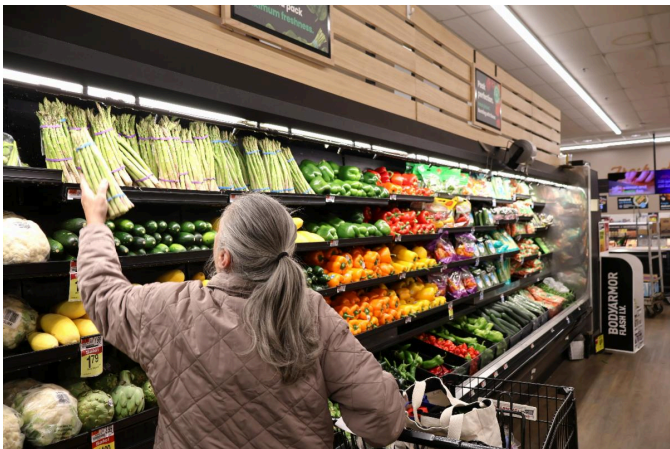

The Tempus Unlimited **Veteran Directed Care (VDC) Program** is a VA Healthcare System Program that works with Massachusetts Aging and Disability Network Agencies (ADNAs) to provide the VDC program to Massachusetts Veterans and Rhode Island Veterans. This program provides Veterans in need of nursing home level care, a budget to buy services to support them in their homes. Tempus Unlimited performs employer-required tasks and related administrative tasks for individuals (“Employers”) in our VDC Program as the Fiscal Intermediary (FI).

What Services are Available?

- Hiring private caregiver(s) to complete activities of daily living (ADLs) such as eating, bathing, dressing, grooming, and toileting
- Adult day health care
- In-home respite services from community home care agencies
- Assistive technology such as emergency response systems and electronic pill reminders
- Snow removal
- Durable Medical Equipment (DME) and personal care supplies not provided by the VA
- Individual requests for medically necessary items will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis

Eligibility

The Veteran:

- Is Enrolled in the VA Healthcare System
- Has had a Primary Care appointment with a VA Medical Center primary care provider during the previous 12 months
- Is dependent on another person to complete -bathing, grooming, dressing, toileting, eating, ambulation, transferring, and bed mobility.
