Scope of Services

TEAM Program Equity

At Tempus Unlimited, access to life-changing therapeutic resources should never be determined by age, income, or background. The TEAM Program is built on a foundation of equity, inclusion and person-centered justice.

Target Population & Eligibility

TEAM serves individuals across the entire lifespan from early childhood to older adulthood- who reside in the community and have a verified medical diagnosis or developmental/physical disability. Eligibility must be re-verified annually through a clinical attestation process.

Core Service Delivery

TEAM Operates strictly as an individual-funding program. Funding is awarded directly to individual applicants/families allowing them the autonomy to select approved, certified providers that best meet their unique therapeutic goals.

Authorized Therapeutic Modalities

To support holistic development and mental, emotional and physical well-being, TEAM exclusively funds for specific, non-traditional therapeutic pathways:

Program Model & Structure

Direct-pay funding model to vendors

To maximize financial accessibility and reduce administrative strain on families, TEAM operates on a direct-pay to vendor model. This structure eliminates the need for families to pay out of pocket upfront or wait for an insurance reimbursement.

How it works:

Payment in Full: Tempus Unlimited reimburse approved providers directly and in full for authorized services, utilizing pre-negotiated rates established during the vendor application process.

Net 30 Terms: Payments disbursed on a predictable Net 30 Schedule. The 30-day processing window begins automatically upon receipt of a completed monthly invoice.

Eligibility Criteria

TEAM determines eligibility using three straightforward requirements. Applicants must meet all three criteria to qualify for funding or device provisions during each annual benefit year.

All-Age Diagnosis & Disability Verification

The program supports individuals across the entire lifespan—from early childhood through older adulthood. Applicants must provide documentation of a formal medical diagnosis or developmental/physical disability. This is verified annually by required attached documentation submitted with the Annual application such as a current IEP, Current ISP, Current 504 Plan, formal diagnosis from applicant's physician.

Individual-Focused Application Path

Funding is strictly awarded through an individual intake process. Under no circumstances can an organization, school district, or day habilitation provider apply on behalf of a group. The application must be submitted directly by the adult applicant, surrogate, parent, or legal guardian.
